- Term “15A Socket” to promote L2 charging
  - No Investment
  - Simple and Easy
  - Simpler pricing models

# Proposal 2

- L2 (or slow charger) investments going to be wasted in near Future.
- Infrastructure is limited to 7KW
- Battery capacity increasing
- Investment actually provide very little extra benefit from already existing EVSE comes with the vehicle
