- Ceylon Petroleum Corporation has failed to submit relevant information and documents as requested by the letter PUC/COA2022/CPC/02 dated 13th October 2022, to this Commission to date despite several reminders.
- Ceylon Electricity Board has submitted a Proposal for an electricity price revision and the tariff decision shall be made on the basis of reasonable cost as per Section 30 of the Public Utilities Commission Act of Sri Lanka. It is important to determine the reasonableness of input cost of the electricity and liquid petroleum supplied by Ceylon Petroleum Corporation is one of the main cost drivers of electricity.
- Therefore, Commission requires the requested information relevant to present context further 3. to above reference letter dated 13.10. 2022 (attached hereto) to determine the reasonable costs and in term a cost reflective tariff under Section 30 of the Electricity Act of Sri Lanka. The required information is listed below for your easy reference.
 - Costs of following fuel types procured for the period for November 1, 2022 to January 10, 2023 or the last shipments. You are required to indicate the costs and qualities of each shipment clearly.
 - Cost of Furnace oil i.
 - Cost of Naphtha ii.
 - Cost of Diesel iii.
 - Cost of Crude oil Iv.
 - In order to justify the above costs, you are required to submit following document, for each shipment imported during the referred period.
 - Commercial Invoice of each shipment i.

- ii. Custom Declaration Form of each shipment
- iii. Money Remittance advice for the bank each shipment
- The above information and documents shall be submitted to this Commission on or before 19th January 2023 in order to consider the referred electricity revision.
- 5. Also, your attention is drawn to the fact that failure or neglect to provide the requested information by such time, will lead the Commission to take further action in accordance with Section 15 of the Public Utilities Act 35 of 2002, without further notice.
