Tariff Revision - 2022

Reference is made to Section 17(h) of the Public Utilities Commission of Sri Lanka Act No.35 of 2002, Section 30(2)(a) of Sri Lanka Electricity Act No.20 of 2009 and your letter dated 19 March, 2022 (ref-DGM(CS&RA)/TRF/trf.2022).

The Commission approved 'Decision on Electricity Tariffs – 2022' is attached herewith. The Licensees are required to comply with specific provisions therein.

Williams to draw your attention to following conditions pertaining to the said tariff decision;

1. Licensee shall complete following requirement by the deadline given below, and the Commission will not consider any future tariff revision if these conditions are not fulfilled to ensure reasonableness of the tariffs in line with the section 30(2)(b) of the Sri Lanka Electricity Act, No. 20 of 2009.

Enabling Provision	Requirement	Completion Date
Condition 33 of the Transmission and Bulk Supply License	Power Sales Agreements (PSA) between Distribution Licensees and Transmission Licensee	30 th November 2022

- 2. LECO shall treat every consumer equally with respect to billing, revenue collection and disconnections, irrespective of their tariff category, influence they can make or any other factor
- 3. The above-mentioned decision is effective from 10th August 2022.
- 4. In terms of Section 30 (2)(d) of Sri Lanka Electricity Act, No. 20 of 2009, the revised tariffs shall be published in your website and in newspapers (Sinhala, Tamil and English)
