

Revision of Electricity Tariff

This is in reference to your letter dated 12.05.2022 on the above captioned matter.

It is informed that the General Treasury has transferred Rs.80 billion to Ceylon Electricity Board (CEB) hitherto for year 2022 as equity infusion to settle its' outstanding obligations to Ceylon Petroleum Corporation (CPC) considering the adverse financial situation of the CEB mainly due to unavailability of cost reflective tariff formula for electricity. However, the General Treasury does not have fiscal space further to accommodate any losses incurred by the CEB.

In this context, General Treasury does not have any objection on implementing proposed tariff in consultation with relevant stakeholders and following necessary procedures at this juncture.
